

Pumpkins in the Park rules

1. The main part of each entry must be a pumpkin or a member of the pumpkin family.
2. Pumpkins may not be carved or hollowed out.
3. Pumpkins may not be larger than 2' x 2' x 2'.
4. Pumpkins entered must be reclaimed after the contest or they will be disposed of (they will be displayed in City Hall until Halloween).
5. Objects and materials used to decorate pumpkins may not be reclaimed until after the contest, under any circumstances.
6. Objects, paper and materials of any kind may be pinned or glued to pumpkins. Participants may also draw or paint on their entries, cut designs into their surfaces or dress them up. Again, ***do not carve or hollow out your pumpkin.***
7. No electrical device may be used as part of any entry.
8. Each entry must have a title.
9. Entries must be ready for display at Nipper Park between 1:30-2 p.m. Oct. 28, 2018
